



LOS ANGELES COUNTY FACT SHEET CEMETERY DISTRICTS



To assume responsibility for the ownership, improvement, expansion, and operation of cemeteries and the provision of interment services from fraternal, pioneer, religious, social, and other organizations that were unable to provide for those cemeteries.



QUALIFICATIONS

Must be a voter within the District.

Some knowledge or experience may be required.



TERM OF OFFICE*

4 Years

4 years and until the appointment and qualification of the successor.

MEETINGS

A board of trustees shall meet at least once every three months.

Additional time commitment may be required.



COMPENSATION

None.

Serves without compensation.



DUTIES*

To maintain a cemetery or cemeteries.

Provide interment services within its boundaries.

TERM OF OFFICE

The term of office for a member of the board of trustees shall be for a term of four years and until the appointment and qualification of the successor. Terms of office commence at noon on the first Monday in January.

For Districts formed before January 1, 2004, where the members of the Board of Trustees are not serving staggered terms, the Board of Supervisors shall stagger the terms of the trustees and to accomplish this purpose shall appoint Trustees, on or after January 1, 2004, for terms of less than four years, thereafter the terms shall be four years.



DUTIES

A district may own, operate, improve, and maintain cemeteries and provide interment services within its boundaries.


A district shall maintain the cemeteries owned by the district.

The district that owns a cemetery shall have exclusive jurisdiction and control over its maintenance and management.



OATH

Required.
